"This Year's Supreme Court Cases" - Mike Berkowitz - Instructor

Beginning Wednesday, Jun 23, 2021 at 1 PM, running for 6 weeks

Along with reviewing the relevant laws and landmark cases from the past, this class will look at twenty of the decisions made by the Supreme Court of the United States during the 2020 - 2021 term. Topics will include health care coverage, religion, children's rights, international issues, pay for college athletes, gun seizures, and immigration. Class meetings will consist of mini-lectures, summaries of significant court cases, and open discussion of related contemporary issues.

York County Senior College is trying a new approach with this course! We are joint venturing with South Coast Senior College, registrations and payment to be made through our respective colleges as usual, and with all joining via Zoom in one class on Wednesday afternoons.
